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Federal Funds Available to Local Emergency Food and Shelter Providers

Bellingham — Whatcom County will receive federal funds to supplement emergency food and shelter programs of non-profit and government agencies during the coming year.

Public or private organizations interested in applying for Emergency Food and Shelter Program funds must attend a Technical Assistance Meeting on October 10 at 9:30 AM at Brigid Collins Family Center, 1231 N. Garden Street, Bellingham. All applicants must attend. To register for the meeting, contact United Way at 360-733-8670

The deadline for completed applications is November 2, 2007.

Under terms of the federal grant, local organizations chosen to receive funds must: 1) be private voluntary non-profits or units of government, 2) have an accounting system, 3) practice non-discrimination, 4) have demonstrated the capacity to deliver emergency food and/or shelter programs, and 5) if they are a private voluntary organization, they must have a voluntary board. Qualifying organizations are urged to apply.

The total amount of funds awarded to Whatcom County will be determined in November, and may range from \$65,000 to \$100,000

A Local Board will determine how the funds awarded to Whatcom County are to be distributed among the emergency food and shelter programs run by local service organizations in the area. The Local Board is responsible for recommending agencies to receive these funds and any additional funds available under this program.

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
